Eligibility Requirements

Prospective instructors for the Clean Water Certificate (CWC) Training Program may be employees of workforce development organizations, industry professionals hired as contractors by a workforce development organization, or they may be industry professionals or municipalities responsible for training entry-level staff in their green infrastructure construction and/or maintenance company or division. Instructors for the CWC Program should have the following minimum qualifications:

- Completion of the Center's Clean Water Certificate Instructor
 Preparation Program virtual training course
- Post-secondary degree in an environment-related area and a minimum of two (2) years of work experience in the stormwater industry or five (5+) years of experience in the stormwater industry
- Knowledgeable in the regulations governing the installation, maintenance, and inspection of stormwater management
- Demonstrated training experience in stormwater management or another related field
- Work or training experience with the intended audience of the training program
- Excellent communication and organizational skills
- Valid driver's license
